



8.493 individuals, families, churches and businesses provided financial assistance.

329,356 pounds of food was donated or rescued.

546 cans of infant formula and **1,143** packages of diapers were provided.

SUCCESS BY THE NUMBERS



95,329 meals were served throughout the year.

2,017 food boxes were distributed to **478** needy families. Another **146** food boxes were delivered during the holiday season. Men in recovery programs participated in **8,106** hours of Bible study, discipleship training and Christian counseling. Volunteers devoted **4,904** hours of service to Mission programs.

There were **42,338** overnight stays in our emergency shelter (an average of **116** men per night). **221** men committed their lives to Jesus Christ during evening chapel services and **10** men were baptized. Programs and Services 74.2%

17 KitchenPrep students were trained to become food service professionals and **3** men were placed in careers as truck drivers. **622,697** pounds of books were diverted from local landfills thanks to the NewLeaf Book Mercantile.
