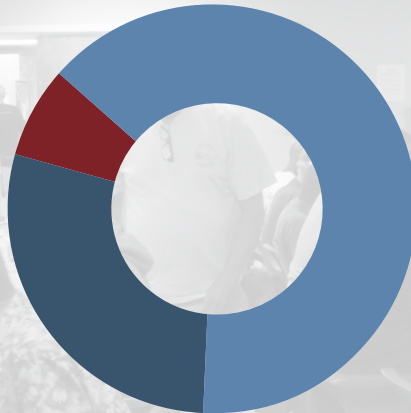

SUCCESS BY THE NUMBERS



99,972 meals were served throughout the year.



1,712 food boxes were distributed to **478** needy families. Another **220** food boxes were delivered during the holiday season.



Men in recovery programs participated in **11,480** hours of Bible study, discipleship training and Christian counseling.



Volunteers devoted **5,164** hours of service to Mission programs.

SUCCESS BY THE NUMBERS



There were **47,958** overnight stays in our emergency shelter (an average of **131** men per night).



1,800 cans of infant formula and **965** packages of diapers were provided free to families and single mothers.



8 KitchenPrep students were trained to become food service professionals.



602,323 pounds of books were diverted from local landfills thanks to the NewLeaf Book Mercantile.
