


"I was blessed by God to have been placed in this position at URM in 2019. The fact that I get to lead the dedicated staff serving men and families in Wichita is my privilege.




**8,673** individuals, families, churches and businesses provided financial assistance.

## SUCCESS BY THE NUMBERS



**99,972** meals were served throughout the year.

**1,712** food boxes were distributed to **478** needy families. Another **220** food boxes were delivered during the holiday season.

Men in recovery programs participated in **11,480** hours of Bible study, discipleship training and Christian counseling.

Volunteers devoted **5,164** hours of service to Mission programs.

## SUCCESS BY THE NUMBERS



There were **47,958** overnight stays in our emergency shelter (an average of **131** men per night).

**1,800** cans of infant formula and **965** packages of diapers were provided free to families and single mothers.

**8** KitchenPrep students were trained to become food service professionals.

**602,323** pounds of books were diverted from local landfills thanks to the NewLeaf Book Mercantile.
