James was a loving husband and father and a hardworking man with a successful career. Then his company cut back on staff, leaving him to carry much more than his share of the work. "I started having anxiety attacks, so I started drinking a little bit and then a little bit more," he says. "I ended up losing our house and my family, so I drank even more to get rid of that pain."

For the next eight years, James struggled with his addiction and with homelessness, staying at our Emergency Shelter along the way. "I'd straighten up for a few weeks and get a job, but I'd always start drinking again and lose it."

Then, one morning, he awakened in the hospital after a night of heavy drinking and he

had a moment of clarity. "I said, 'I want to find a better life. I want my daughter back in my life and to be happy again."

The Mission gave me a place to heal.

It was then he entered our STEPS program, where Bible studies, chapel services and Christian counseling led him to surrender his life to the Lord. "The Mission brought God into my life.

They helped me understand what the Bible means and what

**Jesus has done for me**," he says. "Now I have no more anxiety attacks. I just pray."

James' relationship with his daughter has been restored, and he enjoys spending time with her and his grandchildren. "They're really proud of me and I love being in their lives."

Now a program graduate, he lives in our Eagles Wing Transitional Housing and enjoys full-time employment and benefits in a great local company. "I have a new life," he says.

James is beyond grateful for this second chance in life – and says it's thanks to the love you've shown for a neighbor like him. "Before I came to the Mission, I was lost, but now I'm saved and it's changed my world."

## HELP US REBUILD DREAMS!

For more than 70 years, the Union Rescue Mission has been ministering to the spiritual, physical and emotional needs of homeless, impoverished and hurting people in our community. And, every year, the need grows.



But we don't have the space to expand our ministry. There are men waiting for room in our New Beginnings and STEPS programs, where they can transform their lives. And there are homeless men who need a place to stay and begin their journey of healing.

We've launched our **Dreams Rebuilt Campaign** so we can meet these growing needs! Through this critical effort, we will:

- Renovate our recently-acquired downtown building and relocate our Emergency Shelter to the new space, doubling
  capacity to 125 beds. The renovated facility will enable us to better identify and meet the initial needs of clients and
  assure they are on the path to sustainable living.
- Renovate our current facility to serve as a Life Change Center, increasing STEPS and New Beginnings program capacity



by 20 beds. The Center will provide support services that equip program guests to enter our independent living program at Eagles Wing.
