### **Dreams Rebuilt!**Capital Campaign Update

Through friends like you, the Mission is over halfway to our capital campaign goal of \$3.8 million!

Our Dreams Rebuilt Campaign answers the rising needs of the homeless in our community. Dozens of men are eager to join our Solid Ground program to get off the streets and begin turning their lives around. However, we don't have room for all of them

The Dreams Rebuilt Campaign will double our current capacity to help more people in need! Your support will:

- Renovate our new downtown building and relocate our emergency shelter. This will provide 125 beds.
- Supply a kitchen and dining area, laundry, chapel, common lounge and courtyard in the renovated facility.
- Increase our Solid Ground program capacity to an additional 20 men.
- Establish a new gathering space for 100 guests so they can network and encourage each other.

### "The work of the Lord is in this building."

Paul doesn't know where he would be without Union Rescue Mission . . . or even if he would be alive.

His troubles started early. Raised by grandparents, Paul began smoking at 10 years old. He had his first drink of alcohol at age 12. A difficult teen, Paul was sent to group homes until he took off on his own at 17.

Paul's life continued to spiral down while in and out of prison for various crimes. Eventually, Paul married and had two children. However, when his wife introduced him to meth, Paul's life really began to spin out of control.

"I went back to prison. I lost my wife, my kids, my family," he recalls. When Paul's wife died, he realized that he had to turn his life around or he would suffer the same tragic end. Paul came to Union Rescue Mission, and it was the turning point of his life. Paul enrolled in programs at the Mission that rooted him in Scripture, prayer and provided life-changing support groups. He says, "URM saved my life!"

Today, Paul works at the bookstore at the Mission and has hope for his future.

"Every day is a day to learn and grow stronger," Paul says. "I've been offered a future and work at the Mission. The most important thing is that I've been learning about Jesus. I'm becoming a different person than the man who first arrived here. All glory to God!" As Thanksgiving nears, Paul says he is grateful for the Mission and all who support it. "I appreciate the meals, clothes and life needs. I arrived here with nothing but prison clothes," Paul explains. "I can't thank the donors enough for the new life I have found through the mission. I'M THANKFUL! The work of the Lord is this building." Please continue to pray for people like Paul who arrive at the Mission needing a fresh start.

### Join the Celebration!


